## Duke of Edinburgh 2024/25

### Gold – Year 12

Dear Parent / Carer,

We are delighted to launch the Duke of Edinburgh's award at Lymm High School for this year and we hope your child might choose to sign up. Last year, we had nearly 250 students sign up and it has been fantastic to see participation remain high for several years now. We continue to offer all 3 awards in school and these will be open to all students in the 3 year groups below, thanks to the continued collaboration with *Get Outside The Classroom (GOTC)*, the expedition provider we have worked with for the last 7 years. We will be offering the following awards this year:

- Bronze to Year 9
- Silver to Year 10
- Gold to Year 12

We do not offer the Duke of Edinburgh's award in Years 11 and 13 due to our students' external examinations, but students in these years are welcome to pursue DofE awards outside of school if they wish.

The **Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award** is available to **Year 12**, Bronze is available to Year 9 and Silver is available to Year 10. Students do not need to have done a previous DofE award to sign up for Gold but it will make their section lengths shorter if they've done Silver.

We would thoroughly recommend taking some time to access this information before committing to any payments or expedition dates. We will be hosting a parent information meeting about the Gold DofE Award, in early November, and urge you to attend if you feel you need further guidance on the signing up process and the award schedule/expectations. A DofE Award is an enormously valuable programme and is recognised worldwide. Universities and employers are looking for more than just strong academic achievement and participation in extra-curricular activities, so emphasising involvement in DofE on a UCAS or job application can tell an institution or employer that a student is ambitious, has demonstrated leadership skills and commitment, and has spent time helping other people in their community.

The cost of the Gold Award this year is **£495**, which covers the training day, 2 expeditions, insurance, loan of various equipment and the DofE registration pack. It is important to make you aware that the school operates the Duke of Edinburgh's award on a 'not-for-profit' basis. Equipment such as tents, stoves, fuel bottles, maps, compasses, sleeping mats and rucksacks can all be borrowed from GOTC free of charge and any monies remaining in budgets at the end of the year are reinvested to ensure future participation.

We are now open to enrolment, but please be aware, there is a deadline of **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2024** for participants to secure a place.

<b>8<sup>th</sup> November</b>	<b>£100</b> (non-refundable deposit to secure place) as well as return of reply slip at bottom of letter. By returning this reply slip you confirm they are able to complete the compulsory training day in school and both the practice and qualifying expeditions. Please note, if a student misses either the training day or practice expedition, it is highly unlikely they will be able to complete the qualifying expedition with us this year.

Please be aware that in the unlikely event of a conflict in dates occurring, injury/illness or family emergency preventing a student's participation in any expedition or training day, unfortunately it may not be possible to refund monies paid, due to costs already incurred by the school. You may wish to explore personal travel insurance options where your provider allows before signing up. Circumstances for a need to withdraw are by their nature very individual and we would ask you to contact Mark Harnden via email ([mark@getoutsidetheclassroom.co.uk](mailto:mark@getoutsidetheclassroom.co.uk)) as soon as possible should any issues arise. Contacting us early gives you the best possible chance of a least a partial refund. We would also ask you to cross-reference the expedition dates with your family calendar and ensure you are able to drop-off and pick-up your child on the expedition dates indicated before signing up to ensure your child can commit to the award fully.

Please be aware that in order to keep costs down for participants, parents are required to drop off and collect for all DofE expeditions (you may find it helpful to car share).

Participants will be given access to an online eDofE account and shown how to add their section aims and evidence after we purchase places (this will be done on a weekly basis during the sign-up window). DofE now send registration packs direct to students' home addresses but we will continue to get students logged on and set-up on eDofE in a registration session in school where needed. Once students have completed the aims and chosen their activities for their sections, they simply need to follow their commitments and obtain the important Assessor's Report as soon as they have finished.

We now have two staff to support – a DofE Administrator: Mrs Riley, who is also our school receptionist and can help with all aspects of the DofE awards, especially eDofE queries.
