Life Programme

Our next extended Life Programme is on **Thursday 6th June**. Students will study the following topics.

Year 7: Using a Bank Account

This session is using resources by Money Sense and introduces students to how banking works and the safest way you can use your bank account to protect your money. It gets students thinking about keeping money safe but also the different options they have for having a bank account.

Year 8: Coping with Different Mental Health Issues

This session follows on from other sessions we have looking at mental wellbeing. In this case, we explore how our thoughts and feelings can change across the day. We examine the difference in the normal fluctuations we have and when we may be in more times of need or crisis. The session builds resilience and looks at coping strategies for when we are struggling.

Year 9: Drugs, Alcohol and Social Norms

This session is aimed at exploring the social norms around drugs and alcohol. We explore how the media has normalised some behaviours that can lead to more risk taking in people without fully understanding potential consequences. We begin by looking at the way we access medications and whether we understand how they impact our body and health, before moving onto the way alcohol is presented to us.

Life Programme

Our next extended Life Programme is on **Thursday 6th June**. Students will study the following topics.

Year 10: Drugs, Alcohol and Risky Behaviours

This builds on the session last year with more explicit exploration of the way drugs and alcohol are risks in themselves but can lead to impaired decision making and increased risk taking. We explore the law around alcohol and gain an understanding of how units are measured and how that can impact our body. The session ends with the students exploring some scenarios around these risks.
