I would like to take this opportunity to inform you about two proposed GCSE History trips to London. The proposed trips will take place from 28–30 November 2024 and 12–14 December 2024. The purpose of the trip is to support students’ learning about Crime and Punishment in Whitechapel and Elizabeth I.

The total cost of the trip, which includes all transport, accommodation at the Premier Inn Wembley and meals as stated above is £440 per student.

If you are interested in reserving your son/daughter a place on one of the London trips, please can you complete and return the reply slip by 15th May. There is a strict limit of 35 students as this is the maximum that can be accommodated by the National Archives. The trip has been very popular in previous years, so if it is oversubscribed, names will be selected at random and allocated to either date. Once places and dates have been confirmed, a non-refundable deposit of £80 will need to be paid via Parent Pay to secure your child’s place on the trip no later than 22nd May.
