Life Programme

Our next extended Life Programme is on **Thursday 27th June**. Key Stage 3 students will study the following topics.

Year 7: How to Keep Financially safe

Students will explore some of the financial dangers they may face in the 21st Century. This is to help support them and their money knowledge as we rely more and more on the internet for purchases. They will explore things to be aware of and signposted to where they can get extra support.

Year 8: Eating Disorders and Self-Harm

This is one of the more challenging topics in our Year 8 curriculum and explores ideas around safe coping strategies, as well as busting myths around self-harm and eating disorders. We clearly signpost where pupils can get extra support. We also encourage students to look to support each other and discuss how to be more aware of some of the problems faced by our peers.

Year 9: Positive Family Relationships

This session explores ideas around what we mean by family and the dynamics within these relationships. We also look at conflict in family relationships and how we can resolve this positively by taking an active role in our family life.
