# INDEPENDENT STUDY IN THE ILC

The school library (ILC) is available for Sixth Formers to use for independent study. A copy of the timetable of availability is printed on the ILC entrance door so students can check before they enter the library. For your convenience, we have also provided a copy below.

As the ILC is split into two areas, and bookings are often only for the computer side, the timetable shows separate availability for each area. It shows the lessons that are currently booked in the ILC on a regular basis, but there will be other lessons that need to use the area on an *ad-hoc* basis. The ILC is also subject to full-day closures for events such as photographs, vaccinations, etc, which also won't be on the timetable. However, we will always try to inform you of such closures in upcoming issues of *The Sixth*.

We'd also like to take this opportunity to remind Sixth Formers of the behaviour expectations in the ILC:

- The ILC is a silent study space, and those who can't adhere will be asked to leave.
- There is a strict 'no food' policy for all students. Sixth formers can only bring water in to drink. Anyone found eating will be asked to leave.
- Headphones can be used to listen to music, but mobile phones should not be in use.
