Life Programme

Our next extended Life Programme is on **Tuesday 10th December**. Key Stage 3 students will study the following topics.

• Year 7: Having completed the consent session, Year 7 will recap some of the elements of puberty. They will look at inappropriate touching and physical contact. This will give students the chance to explore appropriate behaviours and apply some of the learning around giving consent and being happy and comfortable with levels of contact.

- Year 8: The final session for Year 8 will be a recap on puberty and the changes we undergo as we approach adulthood. It will also consider the impact some of these changes have, building on the session last year and including some biology.
- Year 9: The final Year 9 session for the RSE unit will explore managing the ending of relationships and cover some aspects of conflict resolution. We will look at identifying and managing feelings as well as looking at ways to end relationships that are not resentful and hurtful.
