
Why are we doing exams?

- We do exams in January and Summer of Year 7, 8 and 9 mainly so we can check you are making good progress in these important subjects. In Summer, you also sit exams in other academic subjects like Humanities and Languages.
- Analysing how you did in each topic or skill helps your teachers reteach certain topics, address misconceptions in your learning and help you improve your subject knowledge and understanding.
- Sitting formal exams like these also gets you used to the exam process, gives you practice of exam technique and timing, hopefully resulting in far better exam results by the time you reach GCSE and A-level exams, which are marked by examiners (not your teachers!).



How to approach these exams...

- Take these exams seriously and revise hard over the next 2 weeks before Xmas and the 2 weeks after Xmas.
- 45-60 per mins per day (split this up between English, Maths and Science). We will be reducing homework in other subjects during this period.
- But it is not the end of the world if an exam doesn't quite go as well as you hoped and we never use a single exam result to decide things like sets or targets.





How much revision should I do?

- Your form tutor will also go through revision techniques and the topics you need to revise using the KS3 Revision Guide.
- Your subject teachers will also do this and direct you towards the best places and revision activities to help you revise.
- Make sure you do 45-60 mins each night (split into the 3 different subjects).
- <u>Everyone</u> needs to revise for these exams, even if you find these subjects easy!

Create the right environment

- Quiet
- Desk
- No phones or TV (put phone in another room so you are not distracted)
- Revision materials and stationery



What revision do I do?

- Go on ClassCharts for revision tasks your teachers have set for you.
- Look at topic lists, quizzes, shadow papers or revision activities in the KS3 revision booklet.
- Look, cover, write, check, using Knowledge Organisers.
- See Ms Crowder's specific revision technique if you don't know how to revise. Being good at revision takes time, practice and perseverance – it is not automatic.
- KEY POINTS ONLY!
