

Medicine and Dentistry work experience

The new personal statement questions have placed greater emphasis on students participating in activities 'outside of school'. Medic Mentor can offer students access to work experience, volunteering, and extra and supracurricular activities that are both outside of school and directly relevant to medicine or dentistry.

Students firstly need to attend a free Get into Medicine or Dentistry Conference, which takes place virtually on Zoom. Within this conference, a team of registered mentors and healthcare professionals will guide Year 12 students through the UCAS application process. This includes personal statement changes, UCAT updates, interview skills, scholarships and how to curate the best experiences for their applications.






