I would like to take this opportunity to inform you about two proposed GCSE History trips to London. The proposed trips will take place from 27–29 November 2025 and 4–6 December 2025. The purpose of the trips is to support student's learning about Crime and Punishment in Whitechapel and Elizabeth I. <u>This trip is only available to students who are picking History as one of their GCSE</u> <u>choices.</u>

The total cost of the trip, which includes all transport, accommodation at the Premier Inn Wembley and meals as stated above is £475 per student.

The trip has been very popular in previous years, so if it is oversubscribed, names will be selected at random and allocated to either date. Once places and dates have been confirmed, a non-refundable deposit of £80 will need to be paid via Parent Pay to secure your child's place on the trip no later than 26th February 2025. A further payment of £80 by 21st April 2025 and the remaining balance by 7th July 2025.
