A Level and BTEC Exams

External examinations are almost upon us, if you wish to see an overview of the dates of these you can find these here. Students will be issued with their individual timetables in due course, it is essential you check these carefully, taking note of you seat number, exam venue and the start time. I know many students find it useful to also have these displayed at home somewhere visible too.

Please note that the sixth form will remain open for study purposes and teachers will be available during lesson time to support you. We feel that you are well supported in school, subject staff, form tutors and the Sixth Form team are always on hand to support should you need it.
