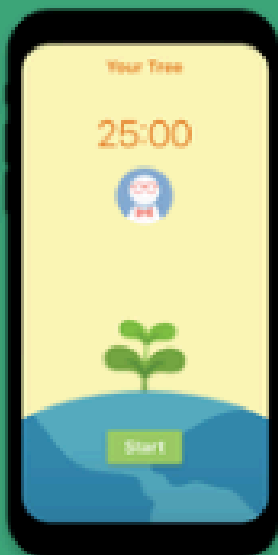

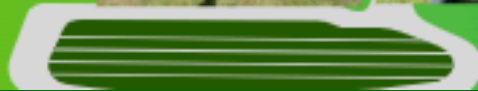

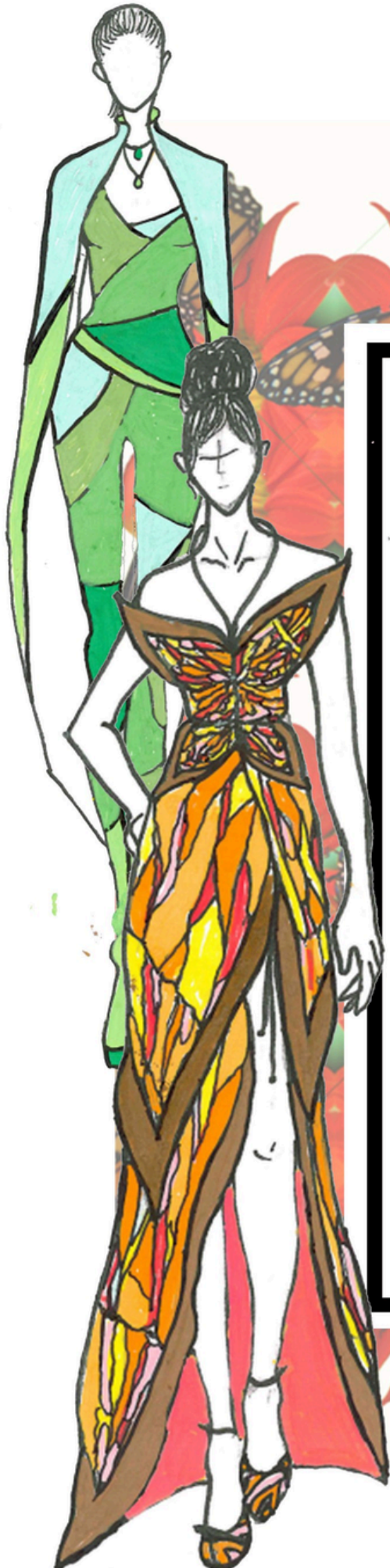

Overview and Expectations

You have already received your **individual exam timetable**. This shows you when your exams take place. It is very much your responsibility to highlight any errors or concerns you may have in advance of this. Please note all exams must be sat on the date allocated. You will not be permitted to change these times, as in the real exam, you cannot change the time/date of the exam. It would only be under exceptional circumstances that changes are made – to ensure the authenticity of the exam and prepare you adequately for the real exams.

It is essential that you **check and pay close attention** to the following:

- Exam dates and start times
- Room and seat numbers
- Any exam access arrangements

It is your responsibility to ensure they attend the correct exam, at the correct time and location.

Study Leave

Study leave will begin on Monday 15th June and end on Friday 19th June. During this time, most lessons will not run, and there will be no Form Time or Supervised Study Periods in the Upper Hex.

For these subjects:

- Lessons will continue as normal throughout the study leave period
- Students must attend their timetabled lessons unless they clash with an exam
- If a student has an exam in the afternoon, they are permitted to miss timetabled lessons in the morning in order to prepare and revise
- Where a morning lesson is missed due to an afternoon exam, students must check with their subject teacher in advance and follow instructions regarding catch-up work, homework, or independent study
- The Sixth Form Canteen will be open as normal.
