### Substance Misuse Assemblies

As part of our ongoing Personal Development and PSHE programme, students will be taking part in an age-appropriate session delivered by The Ways Warrington (Change, Grow, Live): a free and confidential support service for young people aged 10–18 in Warrington who are experiencing issues related to drugs and alcohol. The sessions will focus on solvent abuse and will reinforce the dangers of drug and substance misuse, helping students understand the risks, make informed choices, and know where they can access support if they or someone they know ever needs it.
